

THE HISTORY OF STAR FORMATION AND AGN ACTIVITY FROM DEEP X-RAY OBSERVATIONS

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The Chandra X-ray satellite detects X-rays emitted during accretion onto supermassive black holes, even when they are obscured. I will describe how Chandra surveys have changed our thinking on when and how supermassive black holes formed. I will also present new results on the history of star formation obtained from these data.
